“If ye walk in my statutes, and keep my commandments, and do them; **4** Then I will give you rain in due season, and the land shall yield her increase, and the trees of the field shall yield their fruit. **5** And your threshing shall reach unto the vintage, and the vintage shall reach unto the sowing time: and ye shall eat your bread to the full, and dwell in your land safely. **6** And I will give peace in the land, and ye shall lie down, and none shall make you afraid: and I will rid evil beasts out of the land, neither shall the sword go through your land. **7** And ye shall chase your enemies, and they shall fall before you by the sword. **8** And five of you shall chase an hundred, and an hundred of you shall put ten thousand to flight: and your enemies shall fall before you by the sword. **9** For I will have respect unto you, and make you fruitful, and multiply you, and establish my covenant with you. **10** And ye shall eat old store, and bring forth the old because of the new. **11** And I will set my tabernacle among you: and my soul shall not abhor you. **12** And I will walk among you, and will be your God, and ye shall be my people” (Leviticus 26:3-12).

April, the month of our Easter Conference, derives its name from the Latin verb **aperio**, which signifies to open - because all the buds and blossoms are now opening, and we have arrived at the gates of the flowery year. Prophetically, this speaks of divine opening for blessings.

The resurrection of Christ happened because Jesus remained connected to God to whom all power belong; and to humanity, the centrepiece of God's creation (Philippians 2:5-11). Connecting with God creates connection with His children and releases divine power. “That which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have fellowship with us: and truly our fellowship is with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ” (1 John 1:3).

“I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing” (John 15:5).

in-fighting and brought down the Holy Spirit that turned the fearful into unstoppable preachers. All creation display divine wisdom of connections.
